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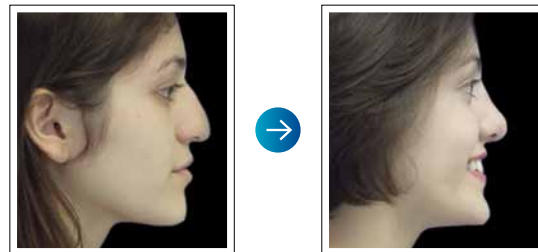

When a rhinoplasty patient said, "Oh my God, you made me beautiful!"
- 5. THE PROCEDURE I PERFORM MOST OFTEN**
Breast augmentation and rhinoplasty are my personal favorites because they are both such important body structures that can effect people's emotional well-being
- 6. WHAT SETS MY PRACTICE APART**
Patients are rarely kept waiting or made to feel rushed. I'm always on time and get to know each patient despite having more than 5000 patients a year
